Dress Code

The sixth form ethos strives to project a **professional** look and environment. Students will be required to be dressed professionally in the following when attending and representing the sixth form, including to and from school.

Male Students

Suit or Trousers & Smart Jacket (compulsory)

- Shirt
- Tie
- Smart & appropriate shoes
- No trainers or footwear of similar ilk
- ID Badges must be worn at all times.

Female Students

- Formal Skirt or Trouser Suit with Smart Jacket (compulsory)
- Skirts to be minimally of knee length & jacket to be waist length
- Blouse or professional smart top (blouses must cover shoulders no strap/string like tops)
- Smart & appropriate shoes
- No trainers or open toed footwear of similar ilk
- ID Badges must be worn at all times

Please note that denim is <u>NOT</u> allowed.

Females

Abayas can be worn, however the smart dress code must be worn underneath and smart jackets/blazer to be worn over the top at all times.

Jewellery

Students are to ensure that jewellery is kept to a minimum of a pair of <u>plain studs</u> & <u>a narrow kara</u>. Students will be requested to remove any items of jewellery deemed inappropriate.

Students who are not wearing suitable clothing or not dressed in a professional manner will be required to return home and change and parents will be informed.

Students should not wear excessive make-up.
