Summer Term

Exploration of the Eastern religions Buddhism

- Exploring the origins of Buddhism
- Exploring the life of Prince Sidhartha
- Examining Buddhist teachings of the 4 Noble truths

Spring Term

Exploration of the Eastern religions Hinduism

- Exploring the origins of Hinduism
- Understanding the Hindu concept of God
- Understanding the importance of Samsara, Moksha and Dharma



Autumn Term

Comparative study of the Abrahamic religions

- Exploring the importance of Abraham in Christianity, Judaism and Islam
- Exploring how Moses was an inspirational leader
- Investigating Jesus and Prophet Muhammed in Christianity and Islam



KS3 learning summary

In KS3 students will broadly explore the similarities and differences between the three major Abrahamic faiths and examine beliefs and teachings from the eastern religions of Hinduism and Buddhism. Students will be able to broadly develop their knowledge and understanding which will provide the foundation for further development in later units of year 7, 8 and 9. Students will be given the opportunity to revisit and improve their skills whilst applying them to a range of religious and non-religious worldviews.
