REMINDER (R1)



Reminder of behaviour expectations. Opportunity to re-focus, reflect and get back on task. **RESET (R2)**



Moved in lesson. Second opportunity to reflect, reset and think about how to modify behaviour. **REMOVE (R3)**



Removed from lesson due to no improvement in behaviour. Restorative conversation to take place.
