As you may be aware, the NEU has called for two further days of industrial action on Wednesday 15th March 2023 and Thursday 16th March 2023.

Students in Year 11 will be undertaking mock examinations and will be dismissed from school following their second examination.

The school day will start at the times listed below for students in school:

- **8.45am** for students in Year 13. Year 13 students are required to report to the Sixth Form Atrium upon arrival to school
- **9.40am** for students in Year 11. Year 11 students are required to report to the Astro Turf upon arrival to school.

Students, who are at home, should use the day to complete homework in their subjects. Homework will be set by teachers however, this may be inconsistent as staff who are striking are under no obligation to set work.
