Students

All children and young people have the right to be and feel safe. This includes all areas of your life including at school, home, when you're with family and whilst online on a laptop, PC or a mobile device.

If you are being mistreated (or aware of another child or young person who is) tell someone at your earliest opportunity.

If you (or another child) is in immediate danger don't delay - call the Police on 999.

The designated Child Protection officer for the school is Mr Noel.

Speak to an adult in school who you know or to one of the school's child protection officers.
