Dress Code for Sports Day: All students should wear their school PE kit on the day that they have Sports Day. This includes a Red Polo shirt, blue shorts/tracksuit bottoms and red socks.

Dress Code for Culture Day: Students will complete a range of workshops based on world cultures. They can come in wearing their:

- full school uniform on this day,
- Or ethnically cultural / traditional clothing to celebrate the diverse cultures of Southall.
- Or the colours associated with a nation's flag,
- Or a t-shirt (no-hood), sweatshirt or sports' top linked to a particular country (for example, national cricket, hockey or football team shirt).
- Or an item of **yellow** clothing to raise awareness of World Mental Health Awareness Day.

Students must **not** come to school wearing caps, hoodies, jeans or any material made from denim, any item of clothing with a message, slogan or image or any expensive items such as jewellery.

Students will need to bring their own **colour pens/pencils for art-based activities** and wear **shoes they can dance in.**

Students can bring in a **packed lunch of their favourite international foods**. We will of course also provide a hot lunch as usual, and the lunch hall will be decorated to celebrate the occasion.
